Vermont Application for Addition to the Checklist

Effective July 1, 2008, the legislature passed an act that allows the **Vermont voter's oath** to be administered by **any person over the age of 18** or the oath can be attested to **by the voter him or herself**. 17 V.S.A. §2124

Therefore, these new voter applications have been printed to reflect this change and shipped directly to your office in advance of July 1.

On July 1, 2008, you should recycle ALL older voter applications! They will no longer contain accurate information. You can see the revision date of an application all the way at the bottom of the application. “[SOS-VR-5/06]” would indicate that the application was revised in May 2006—therefore, discard it!

An additional change to the application that you'll see is a space for the town or city clerk to record the date that the application was entered into the Statewide Checklist and the date that the voter was sent a confirmation notice. This space was created on request of a town clerk, and we hope it will make your record keeping easier.
