Re: Primary Ballots, Programming of Voting Machines and Polling Locations

NUMBER OF PRIMARY BALLOTS

If your town has had a big increase in registered voters since Town Meeting, please email mhodge@sec.state.vt.us or fax to (802) 828-5171 before July 21st what you believe will be your total number of registered voters for the September 12th Primary.

- We will print 50% of your 2006 Town Meeting checklist for Primary Ballots as required by law unless you give us different information.
- For voting machine towns, 40% of your ballots will be scored for use as absentee ballots.

NOT LATER THAN JULY 21st: Towns that are divided into more than one State Representative District or that use more than one polling place must fax your best estimate of the number of registered voters in each District in your town to (802) 828-5171 or email to mhodge@sec.state.vt.us. We cannot send you the right number of ballots for each district unless we receive the Legislative District checklist breakdowns from you.

VOTING MACHINE TOWNS

Each voting machine town is responsible for arranging and paying for programming needed for your voting machines for the Primary and General Election.

POLLING PLACE LOCATIONS

If your BCA has changed any of your polling locations, please notify us by July 21st. Enclosed is a copy of the Vermont Polling Place Locations as we currently have on record. We will need this updated information to post on our website and to print on your Official Return of Votes forms.
