Enclosed please find a REVISED Voter's Oath Letter. It is revised from the July 6 version we sent to include a requirement that the voter who registered to vote through DMV swear or affirm that he/she is a U.S. citizen. When voters complete the DMV change of address form, these are the 2 pieces of information that DMV does not already ask them to provide. As Town or City Clerk, you need to confirm that the voter is a US Citizen and that she/he has taken the voter's oath before adding him/her to the checklist.

Please throw out your copy of the old Voter's Oath Letter and replace it with this revised letter.
