New Applications to the Checklist (Voter Registration Forms)

Enclosed with this memorandum is a supply of the new Applications to the Checklist that Vermont residents wanting to register to vote should now complete. There is now a place for the HAVA-required information including VT DMV Driver's License or Personal I.D. #'s. Instructions for the new required information are on the back of the forms.

There are now only 2 pages to the application. The applicant keeps the 2nd copy and the original must be sent to the Town Clerk in the town where the applicant resides. Town Clerks will now notify the previous town clerk through email on the statewide checklist. After the applicant is added to the checklist, the town clerk will complete the bottom of the form and mail a copy to the applicant.

Please discard and DO NOT distribute any of the old forms that you still have.
